The 2016 CPD cycle instituted under the CPD Regulation (Solicitors (Continuing Professional Development) Regulations, 2015) S.I. 480 of 2015 came into effect on the 1st January 2016 and runs for the calendar year of 2016. Every solicitor who is a sole practitioner or a compliance partner and/or an anti-money laundering compliance partner now has a CPD requirement which includes a minimum of 3 hours regulatory matters at least 2 hours of which shall be accounting and anti-money laundering compliance matters.
